



“La Casa del Limone” - Accomodation

Description

“La Casa del Limone” (The House of Lemon) is situated near the historical/ancient centre of Oria, about five minutes going on foot. Its name derived from a beautiful tree situated in the garden.

The Accomodation represents a useful solution who wants to visit one of the most important destinations of Apulia Tourism.

“La Casa del Limone” is (synonym of) guarantee of confort, taste and hospitality.....everything with a low cost price.

The House, 140 mq, can put up six people. It is composed of two double-bedroom and a comforting hall/entrance with a double divan in which can sleep two people.

It is also characterized by a large/wide dining room, a kitchen, a bathroom with a bath-tub inclusive of shower, a room with a washing-machine, a covered veranda and a garden with a great oven that functions with the use of wood. It is a typical Italian and ancient oven useful to cook bread, bun, etc.

Accessories: refrigerator, gas-cooker, central heating, air conditioning, microwaving oven, phon, TV color and DVD, cooking utensils.

“La Tavernetta in Villa” – Accomodation

Description

It is characterized by an hall, a bedroom for two people (with cradle), a bathroom with shower and a dining room with kitchen.

Accessories: refrigerator, cooking utensils, TV color, phon, electric iron and cookers.

DO NOT LOSE/visiting

The Castle, wanted by Federico II of Svevia, was built between 1225 and 1233 and is situated in the highest hill of the country. It is characterized by a triangular-isosceles base with three big towers, “Quadrata”, “Del Salto”, “Del Cavaliere”. At the feet of “Del Salto”tower, there is the ancient Crypt of St. Crisante and St. Daria, the first Protectors of the country.

The Castle has been residence of Princes, Cavaliers, Marquis and Barons besides being the destination of a great numbers of scholars coming from all over the world.

Basilica and Cathedral built in honour of St. Maria between 1750 and 1756 on the remains of the ancient Church. It is characterized by a beautiful Cupola and a Beltry. Inside the Cathedral there is the **Crypt of Mummies**, where there are 11 skeletons which belong to the Confraternity of Death and Hypogeum of the Cathedral.

Diocesan Museum situated in the Episcopal House built by the Archbishop of Oria Gian Carlo Bovio between 1564 and 1570. It is considered one of the most beautiful Episcopal residence of Apulia.

Religiuos Tourism is represented by **St. Cosimo alla Macchia Sanctuary** in which there are the Churches of St. Maria della Scala, St. Maria di Gallana and St. Lorenzo.

Besides you can visit Salentino Museum, The Centre of Messapic Documentations and Martini House, a baroque building of the XVIII century.

Finally you can taste the main courses of our Restaurants and then you can relax in the Bar of the beautiful Manfredi Square also named "Sedile" Square built in the XVII century.

How to get there

By car – in motorway, go out in order to take Taranto direction. Taking SS 7 Grottagli-Brindisi, turn Oria direction.

By train – You can arrive in 30 minutes both from Brindisi and Taranto.

By aeroplane – from Brindisi airport you can take Taranto-Lecce direction. After 2 km, you must take SS Taranto direction and after about 20 minutes, turn to Oria direction.
